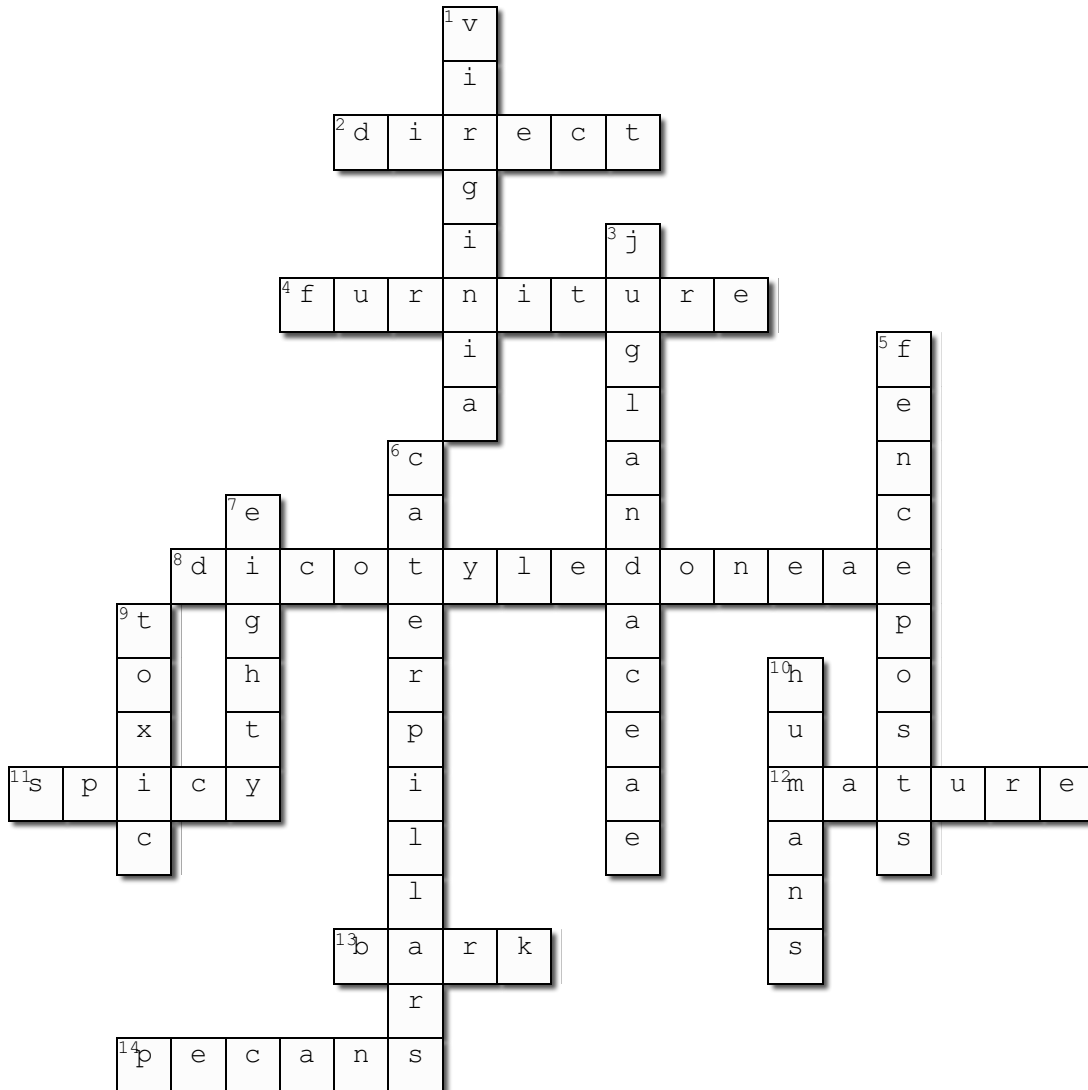


# Black Walnut
