1 in 3 people work in agriculture worldwide - and careers in agriculture indude much more than working directly or a farm.
In 2017, Agriculture and related industries provide 21.6 million full and part time jobs, which is $11 \%$ of total U.S. employment. Of those, only 2.6 million, or $\mathbf{1 . 3 \%}$, were direct on-farm employment.

Less than 2\% of the U.S. population is directly involved in production agriculture...and every farmer produces enough food and fiber for 166 people in the US and abroad.
The U.S. exports more food and fiber than we import $\$ 139.6$ billion of American agricultural products were exported in 2018.

Americans spend $12.9 \%$ of their household income on food - which is less than any other country in the world.

Agriculture, food and related industries accounted for \$1.053 trillion of the U.S. gross domestic product (GDP), or 5.4\% in 2017. American farms were $\mathbf{\$ 1 3 2 . 8}$ billion, or $\mathbf{1 \%}$ of GDP.

Farmers and ranchers receive only 15 cents of every dollar spent on food at home and away. The rest goes to: wages and materials for production, processing, marketing, transportation and distribution.
